You will gain experience of working with a broad range of media, including traditional and new media technologies.

Many students progress onto the BTEC Pre-Degree Foundation in Art and Design and to a variety of high profile BA (Hons) Degree courses. This course will be valuable for students wishing to pursue a career in Art and Design.
