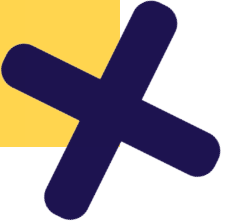

Attendance and Lifetime earnings!



Just wanted to share some important findings from [The Impact of School Absence on Lifetime Earnings Report March 2025](#).

It turns out there's a strong negative link between missing school/college and how well you do at the end of KS4. Basically, the more you miss college, the lower your grades tend to be, even when other factors are considered.

This drop in grades isn't just about school/college; it actually affects your future earnings too. **The report estimates that each day you're absent could cost you around £750 in future earnings!** Plus, missing college increases the chances of needing benefits and reduces the likelihood of having stable employment by the time you're 28.

So, let's try to make it to college as much as we can – it's really important for our future!

Business – Level 2 & Level 3 – The Signing Off Process...

We are now starting to approach the time where you will finish the academic year.
As a result, this is the process for signing off....

Polite Reminders:

- You continue to attend all of your timetabled lessons, even if your coursework unit with a particular teacher is complete.
- Please give your teachers time to mark your work – **Teachers aren't just sitting around waiting for your work to be handed in and some have over 100 students work to mark! Be patient.**
- If you have submitted work, and your teacher is confident that it will meet criteria – **You can be signed off 'pending work marked'.**

The Signing Off Process:

1. Ensure all assignments are complete for all units – **VITAL!**
2. Enter your grades (including exam point scores) into the BTEC Calculator.
3. Print off/Take a picture on your phone of your BTEC Calculator and predicted grade. **WITHOUT THIS YOU WILL NOT BE SIGNED OFF.**
4. Visit SBR (E101) to complete sign off.
5. SBR will complete the Sign Off Spreadsheet and place a message on CEDAR (informing MIS and Tutor/PCO) – 'STUDENT SIGNED OFF FOR 2024' including estimated grade.
6. SBR will then send you to your Tutor to check for final sign off for summer!

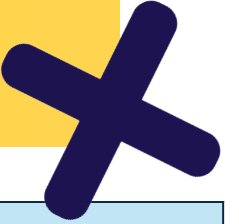

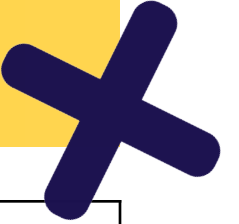

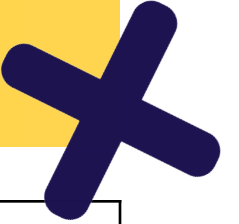
