At Gateway College, we're dedicated to preparing the next generation of professionals through T Levels—career-focused qualifications that blend classroom learning with hands-on industry experience.

We are currently looking for employers to provide T Level industry placements in science labs. Students will need to complete 315 placement hours.

Providers can claim up to £800 towards equipment, training and resources to help support students on placement.
