

### Computing/Engineering – Subject Requirements

#### Computing e.g. Computer Science, Information Technology Management, Software Engineering

- Must include one from: Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Further Mathematics, Computer Science, Computing, or Design Tech.
- BTEC must be in an IT or technical subject. Applied Science also accepted
- BSc/MSci Data Science requires Maths A-level only. BTECs assessed on an individual basis
- MSci degrees require higher level 3 pass rates

### **Engineering** (e.g. Aerospace, Automotive, Civil, Mechanical)

- BEng degrees must include Mathematics
- Some require an additional subject from: *Physics, Chemistry, Design Tech., Biology, Further Mathematics, Electronics*
- BTEC in Engineering must include 'Further Engineering Mathematics' or
   'Calculus to Solve Engineering Problems'
- MEng degrees require higher level 3 pass rates

### Other Sciences – Subject Requirements

### Life Sciences (e.g. Biomedical Science, Human Bioscience, Pharmacology)

- Must include Biology
- Specific BTEC units required

#### Forensic and Nutrition Sciences (e.g. Forensic Science, Nutrition and Health, Food Science)

- Must include Biology or Chemistry
- Specific BTEC units required

#### Sport Sciences (e.g. Sports and Exercise Science, Sports and Exercise Therapy, Sports Coaching)

- Must include Biology or Physical Education
- Sports Coaching will also accept Psychology or Sociology (or Biology or Physical Education)
- Specific BTEC units required

### **Health and Care** – Subject Requirements

### Students need to apply before January 14 2026

Nursing (e.g. Adult Nursing, Learning Disabilities Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Nursing Associate, Occupational Therapy, Social Work)

- Interview required (apart from BSc Public Health)
- No subject requirements
- Level 2 English and Maths e.g. GCSE at grade 4 or above may be required

### **Midwifery**

- Interview required
- Relevant sport, science or social science subject required

### Other healthcare degrees (e.g. Dietetics, Diagnostic Radiography, Physiotherapy, Paramedic Science)

- Interview required
- Must include Biology, some degrees may accept other science or health related subjects
- For those courses where a particular subject is required at A-level, an equivalent must be studied within your BTEC or T Level, if you are taking vocational qualifications.
